Mer-Blanc is the name chosen for this delightful and delicious blush wine made from Merlot grapes. The Merlot grapes were crushed and immediately pressed with the skins left behind along with the harsh tannins, leaving only the clean fruity juice for fermentation.

Mer-Blanc is well balanced, fresh smooth and fragrant. Up front, the cherry and light cranberry open up to ripe watermelon and strawberries.

Mer-Blanc is bottled young to capture the essence of the fruity white wine with the complexity of a rosé wine.

The crispness and light spritz of this wine will go well with an afternoon cheese and fruit plate, salmon or and light pasta.
